The milestones can be classified as Statuses, Notifications and Alerts

STATUSES

Statuses represent the exact condition of your shipment. Thanks to the status you can understand whether your shipment sailed, discharged, or booked.

We have 5 statuses. The meanings of them are as follows;



NOTIFICATIONS

The notifications are **informative messages** about the seaway voyage. Thanks to the voyage notifications you are aware of the usual stages of seaway transportation from the loading to the gate out. By getting notifications you escape from **unexpected costs**, inform the responsible parties, and **plan the transportation** after arrivals easily.

VOYAGE SUMMARY

It is a general summary of the shipment's voyage. It contains port names, vessel names, arrival/departure dates, carrier names, container number/BL number, shipment references.




GATE OUT CONFIRMATION

When your container actually gated out from the port of discharge we let you know by the Gate Out Confirmation. It contains vessel name, port names, discharge date and gate out date.

ARRIVAL NOTICE

When your shipment arrived at POD we let you know. It is the same format with the voyage summary but with the green tick at the place of the Vessel Arrival.




ALERTS

Alerts are **the warning messages** that ShipsGo sends you when **any abnormalities** are captured.

Thanks to Alerts you can take action before big losses occur.

DELAY AND EARLY ALERTS

We check the carrier website 3 times a day and when any change is captured at ETA we let you know about the delays and early arrivals. It is the same format as the Voyage Summary but with delay/early explanation.



RELEASE ALERT

After your container arrives at the port of discharge(POD) we keep checking the carrier website to capture the gate out date. You get Release Alert with the number of the days when your container has been waiting at the POD if your container hasn't been acted out.

T/S PORT PENDING ALERT

If your container waits more than 8 days at the transshipment ports(TS) we let you . know. Because your container may have missed the scheduled vessel. TS Port Alerts also shows how many days your container has been waiting at TS Port.
